Responsibilities:

- Platform musicians are expected to have good character in line with the expectation of our Music Pastor and Senior Pastor.
- Platform musicians are expected to have a real, relevant and current relationship with Jesus.
- Platform musicians are expected to dress in a way that is respectful of the service. (See Music Dress Code)
- Platform musicians are expected to be at rehearsals for special events, such as Easter, Christmas, Etc.

Relationships:

The Production team and Band will work together as a team to maximize the excellence that is needed to make a Sunday service run. Audio Engineers will monitor our sound levels, gains and EQ's. They will assist us with our tones and levels. Audio Engineers and Band Director will work together on the sound and blend.
